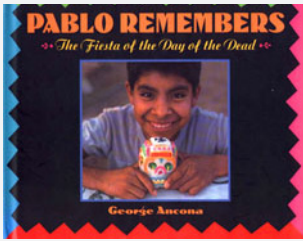

About the SEAL-GD Learning Opportunity:

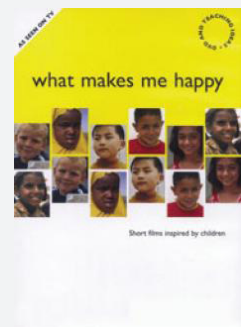

About the SEAL-GD Learning Opportunity:

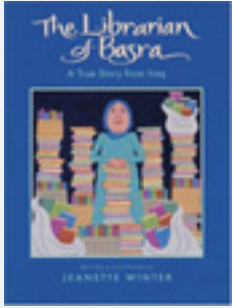

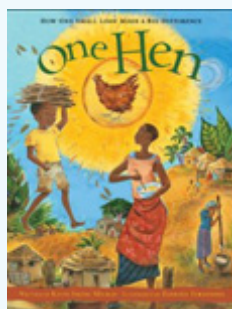


About the SEAL-GD Learning Opportunity:
